



## <sup>1st</sup> Advanced Zooplankton Course – AZC1 Morphological and Molecular Taxonomy of Marine Copepods

Stazione Zoologica Anton Dohrn, Naples, 22 October – 2 November 2018

## 1 stAnnouncement

The Course will be held on 22 October – 2 November 2018 at Stazione Zoologica Anton Dohrn, Naples, Italy.

The Course is organized by the Stazione Zoologica MOTax Service (Marine Organism Taxonomy) and sponsored by Leica.

AZC1 will provide an advanced training on taxonomy of selected copepod families for addressing biodiversity studies in plankton biology and ecology. The aim is to increase and update the expertise of the students in the taxonomy and specific identification of Aetideidae, Corycaeidae, Oithonidae, Oncaeidae, Paracalanidae and Spinocalanidae with emphasis on light microscopy and integrating molecular data and new approaches to the study of planktonic copepods that are commonly and abundantly distributed in epipelagic or mesopelagic regions.

The programme will consist of lectures and practical sessions. During the latter, a diverse collection of preserved material will be offered for examination in light microscopy. Selected material will be observed in electron microscopy.

- methods and criteria for species identification
- taxonomic classification and phylogeny
- molecular identification
- methods for light and electron microscopy
- specialized literature
- general and specific aspects of copepod biodiversity and biogeography
- lectures on copepod evolution, -omics applied to copepods.
